16.4.2011

17.5.2011

Update 6.4 is released in Europe introducing two amazing premium tanks, the Löwe and KV-5 in addition to two new maps, Mountain Pass and Prairies, the Tier 8 SPGs and the KV-13 and Pz38NA tanks.

19.5.2011

Start of Clan Wars and introduction of the Global Map.

23.5.2011

The first World of Tanks in-game special takes place.

24.5.2011

Number of registered users reaches 3.000.000 worldwide.

26.5.2011

Tracer hacks successfully removed.

7.6.2011

World of Tanks client released in 8 additional languages Dutch, Danish, Romanian, Turkish, Finish, Swedish, Estonian and Lithuanian.

29.6.2011
